Ryan Ivey, Athletic Director **Stephen F. Austin State University Update on SFA Athletics** Introduction by Scott Bowyer



Ryan was named Stephen F. Austin State University's Director of Athletics on July 1, 2018, where he immediately got to work in setting the goal for the department: To Become the Best Mid-Major NCAA Division I Athletic Program in the Nation.

Ivey came to SFA following a three-year tenure as the director of athletics at Austin Peay State University in Clarksville, Tenn.

With Ivey at the helm, the Governors increased their national profile across both the NCAA Division I athletics landscape and within the Ohio Valley Conference by posting many impressive winning seasons and announcing numerous major coaching hires. On the fundraising side, Ivey helped raise \$6.5 million in gifts which were funneled into facility improvements and the athletics department budget. Countless academic benchmarks were reached during his tenure at Austin Peay as well, featuring hundreds of student athletes receiving academic recognition.

Prior to Austin Peay, Ivey spent a couple of years at Texas A&M Commerce. In addition to six conference championships in 2015, the Lions had two Division II National Players of the Year, 35 All-Americans, 58 All-Regional Selections, 69 All-Conference players, 11 Lone Star Players of the Year, 11 National All-Academic athletes, 14 conference All-Academic athletes, two Lone Star Team Academic Champions, a State Coach of the Year, two Regional Coaches of the Year and a Regional Assistant Coach of the Year. Ivey has also spent time at McNeese State, Memphis and the University of South Dakota.

A student-athlete at Memphis, Ivey suited up for the Tigers' football team for four years and earned both his Bachelor's and Master's Degrees from Memphis.

Ivey is married to the former Kelley Holt from Fayetteville, Tennessee. The couple has two sons - Jett and Ace.
