Paige Pattillo is proud to have been born in Nacogdoches! She started attending Stephen F. Austin State University as an infant and graduated from the SFA lab school after first grade. At that time, she knew she was a Lumberjack for life! Paige attended NISD for middle school and high school. In 1996, she came back to SFA for her undergraduate degree. In 2000, she graduated Summa Cum Laude with a major in Political Science and a minor in History. From 2000-2001 she worked in Austin for Senator Kay Bailey Hutchison and was the reading clerk for the Texas House of Representatives. In 2004, Paige graduated from The University of Texas School of Law.

Throughout her academic career Paige has always twirled. She was the Feature Twirler for the Nacogdoches Dragon band, SFA Lumberjack Marching band, and The University of Texas Longhorn band. In high school, she competed in the State UIL twirling competition earning the highest rating and title Outstanding Performer from every judge. During her time at SFA, she won 7 national championships in different twirling divisions. In 1999, she placed second in the world.

Upon graduation from law school Paige immediately came home to practice law. She started with the Fairchild law firm and practiced in Dallas, Houston, Beaumont, and all-over East Texas in the areas of medical malpractice defense, family law, as well as wills and estates. After a few years, she was recruited to the Nacogdoches County Attorney's Office by Jeff Davis. Paige has been a prosecutor for approximately 14 years. During that time, she has tried hundreds of criminal cases ranging from speeding tickets to drug cases, DWI's, resisting arrest, and assaults. She loves working in the courtroom and especially enjoys helping victims of crime. She has helped hundreds of women and children who have been abused obtain Protective Orders.

Paige's community involvements include President of the Lumberjack Alumni Band and memberships in Nacogdoches Junior Forum, Heritage Heralds, Nacogdoches Bar Association, American Association of University Women, and Nacogdoches County Chamber of Commerce. She is also a Stephen Minister at First United Methodist Church. For the past 15 years Paige has been honored to judge the State UIL twirling competition. She is married to fellow Rotarian Todd Brown and they have an eight-year-old son named Jackson Baker Brown. Paige, Todd, and Jackson are all lifetime members of the SFA Alumni Association.
